

Town of Fowler Special Meeting Minutes for April 18, 2016 at 6PM

The Special Meeting for the Town of Fowler was held on the above date with all Board Members present except Councilperson Fayette. Also present were Town Clerk Kelly Harmer, Highway Superintendent Randy Durham, Judge Paul Lamson, Tami Gale, Cindy Carr, Evelyn Utter, Barry Wright, Carmen Wright and Marina Wright.

Supervisor Cappellino called the meeting to order at 6 PM. He stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss having a Public Hearing for Local Law No. 1 of 2016 for the Sylvia Lake Beach.

After much discussion, a motion was made by Councilperson Bishop to hold a Public Hearing at the May meeting. There was no second to the motion therefore it was decided not to have the public hearing.

Highway Superintendent Randy Durham stated he would like to start paving in July. He has 5 miles of road that he is looking at paving for 2016. A motion was made by Councilperson Newvine and seconded by Councilperson Simmons to put out to bid the paving of 5 miles of road. The bids will need to be in for the June 7, 2016 meeting. All in Favor.

Councilperson Simmons stated that she had received an email from the auditors. They will email us with an estimate for an Agreed Upon Procedure very soon.

Evelyn Utter stated that she had a few issues with the Gulf Road. She stated that the Sullivan/ Gulf Road intersection has become very wide and she is concerned about this. She also stated that she was having some issues with a culvert on that road affecting an artesian well.

Superintendent Durham stated that he could put some rock down there and maybe divert it and see if there were still issues.

A motion was made by Councilperson Newvine and seconded by Councilperson Simmons to adjourn the meeting at 6:53 PM. All in Favor. MOTION CARRIED.
