

An Emergency Meeting for the Town of Fowler was held on the above date with all Board Members present. Also present were Town Clerk Kelly Harmer, Highway Superintendent Randy Durham, Judge Paul Lamson, Jeff Hill and Vicky Cappellino.

The meeting was called to order at 7 pm.

Supervisor Cappellino stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss time recording issues with the highway employee's time cards from 2015. A motion was made by Councilperson Newvine and seconded by Councilperson Simmons to go into Executive Session at 7:04 PM. The board went into executive session along with Highway Superintendent Durham and Town Clerk Kelly Harmer. All in Favor.

The Board, Highway Superintendent Durham and Town Clerk Kelly Harmer returned from Executive Session at 8:03 pm. Supervisor Cappellino stated that there were some payroll issues discussed. Highway Superintendent Durham will talk to the highway employees about the adjustments that need to be made.

Highway Superintendent Durham discussed the road plans for this coming summer. He intends to do .58 of the Gulf Road, .4 miles of the Hull Road from Route 58 in to the Y with the Doane Road, and the California Road. He figures it will cost around \$279,000 for those roads. He estimates it to cost approximately \$10,000 to replace sluice pipes on these roads. He also discussed doing Mill street in Hailesboro which is .15 miles. Supervisor Cappellino stated that if we get Mill Street ready and the cost of asphalt is still down then we should pave it.

Highway Superintendent Durham and Councilperson Fayette interviewed 4 men for the Seasonal Part time position. Nelson Bice may go off on disability in April so they are looking at hiring 2 part time employees that will start April 1.

A motion was made by Councilperson Newvine and seconded by Councilperson Simmons to close the meeting at 8:40 pm. All in Favor.
